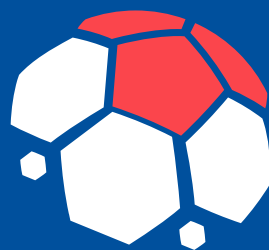

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MEMBERS' FORUM – CODE OF CONDUCT

The School Sport Professionals (SSP) Members' Forum is a supportive space for members to share ideas, discuss challenges, and collaborate on best practices in delivering school sport. To foster a positive, respectful, and productive environment, we ask all members to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Respect and Inclusivity

- Treat all members with respect, regardless of background, experience, or perspective.
- Promote an inclusive environment where everyone feels comfortable sharing their thoughts.
- Avoid offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate language and content.

2. Constructive Communication

- Engage in discussions constructively. Provide feedback in a respectful and helpful manner.
- Avoid personal attacks, inflammatory language, and disruptive behaviour.
- Disagreements may arise but should remain respectful and focused on ideas, not individuals.

3. Professionalism

- Maintain a high standard of professionalism in all posts, comments, and direct messages.
- Refrain from using the forum for self-promotion, including advertising products or services not relevant to the SSP's mission and community.

4. Confidentiality and Privacy

- Respect the privacy and confidentiality of all members. Do not share personal information about other members without consent.
- Refrain from posting or sharing sensitive or proprietary information that could compromise individual or organisational privacy.

5. Stay on Topic

- Ensure posts and discussions remain relevant to the topic of school sport and the interests of SSP members.
- Use appropriate channels for different types of communication, including off-topic or private discussions.

6. Accurate Information

Strive to provide accurate information. When sharing data, quotes, or resources, include proper citations where necessary.

If unsure of the accuracy of information, label it as opinion or provide context to ensure clarity.

7. Reporting Issues

If you observe behaviour that violates this Code of Conduct, report it to forum moderators or SSP administrators.

All reports will be reviewed with confidentiality and appropriate action will be taken.

8. Compliance

All members are expected to comply with this Code of Conduct. Failure to do so may result in warnings, restricted access, or removal from the forum.
